Our Approach

- Utilisation focused to ensure use- co-development of concept, co-funding, ETWG, chairing of dept
- Tabling at cabinet
- Credibility- peer reviewing, steering comm, validation, quality assurance

How are we structured for this?

4 directorates- each sector focused, the each output focused: communication, institutional tools, capacity building



Key accomplishments

- The National Evaluation System gaining traction with Departments both at National and Provincial spheres
- Some evaluations at improvement plan development stage have been used – policy guidelines have been reviewed
- The system is Utilisation Focused, requiring involvement of programme management in each step of the evaluation process for ownership and use
- Seven multi-year National Evaluation Plans were developed with 67 evaluations undertaken
- Advisory panel- ETWG



Key accomplishments

- In total, 8 out of 9 provinces have Provincial Plans.
- 61 departments have Departmental Plans.
- A suite of 8 courses offered to over 6000; DG courses
- DPME has also developed 18 guidelines and 9 templates on various components of the system during the same period.
- Communication on findings- annual reports, policy briefs, BBLs, seminars, conference presentations
- Partnerships

Recommendations

- Evaluation should be embedded in legislation
- Role of impact evaluations strengthened
- Rapid approaches
- Strengthen investment in capacity
- Communication- findings, tracking changes from evaluation

Reviewed Approach

- Latching onto planning framework
- Rapid evaluation guideline
- Gender-responsive guideline
- Build internal capacity to undertake especially adhoc rapid
- Testing a DPME-driven model for selecting evaluations to better align to key priorities
- Testing a model of fully funding
