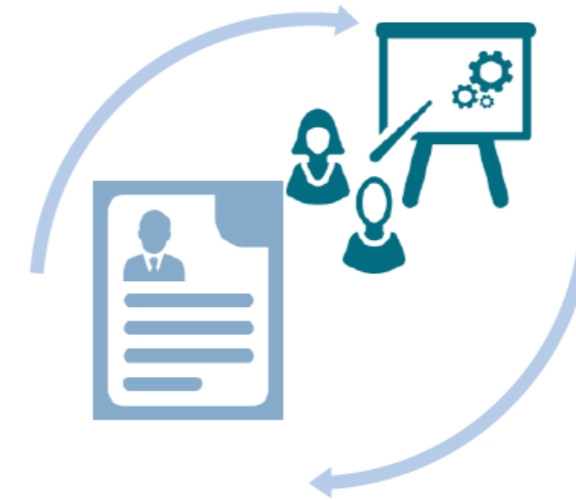
It is a strategy that aims for the development and increase of the evaluation practice in the State of Yucatan, through the building of a young and emerging evaluators' network.
