

- ✓ A better linkage between strategic planning process and the monitoring and evaluation process – the GD on the national strategic planning framework is to be approved by the end of 2019;
- ✓ Strengthen intra- and inter- institutional cooperation in terms of monitoring data and information needed for the planning/monitoring processes process and way that will ensure the cooperation are described in the mentioned GD;
- ✓ Develop capacities for monitoring, reporting and evaluation in ministries and other public authorities after approval of the GD, trainings are to be organized.
