The Independent Evaluation Office (IEO) of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the Government of Egypt, Ministry of Planning, Monitoring and Administrative Reform cordially invite you to participate in the **National Evaluation Capacities (NEC)** Conference to be held from **20 to 24 October 2019** in the beautiful seaside town of **Hurgada, Egypt**.

The main theme of the Conference is **No One Left Behind: Evaluation for 2030**. The conference will focus on the role of national evaluation systems to advance development that leaves no one behind, in line with the commitments made by 193 countries to the Sustainable Development Goals.

Over the last decade, NEC Conferences have been successfully supporting the strengthening of national evaluation capacities. The conferences attract a large number of government officials engaged in evaluation, international evaluation professionals, civil society and the academic evaluation community to share lessons, innovative experiences and perspectives. NEC 2019's unique focus on national perspectives and country-led evaluation will ensure tailor-made discussions and learning, networking and partnerships for national evaluation capacity development.

The event will open with two days of **pre-conference technical training workshops**, especially designed to provide focused opportunities for individual capacity development through innovative learning and hands-on exercises on a range of evaluation topics. This will be followed by a three-day Conference containing a rich and highly interactive programme featuring keynote addresses, panel discussions, interactive sessions, networking and cultural activities.

There is no registration fee for the three-day conference. Exclusive rates for the training workshops are offered (\$200 per one-day or \$400 for two one-day workshops). Participants – or their organizations – are expected to pay travel and accommodation costs as well as any workshop registration fees. Bursary support will be available for a limited number of participants. Eligibility criteria for such support and application procedures are available on the Conference website.

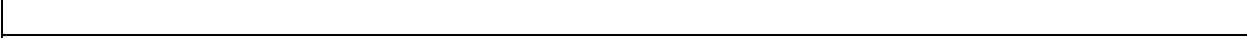
