LOTFA Key Facts

Financ

- Total Donor contribution between 2002-2018 equals to \$5,339,020,312
- Biggest Donors are USA (31,26%), Japan (28.51,%) and EU (10,95%)
- LOTFA Annual turnover is around \$585 mln

Payroll

- More than 100k police officers are receiving their salaries under the project
- Female police officers represent about 2.5% of total ANP
- Several rounds of reconciliation helped remove more than 4,800 unverified police officers from the payroll

MPTF

- MPTF consists of four thematic windows: Payroll, Security, Justice, and Anti-Corruption
- Each thematic window has a set of ongoing or planned projects: Security (TSM, ISM, COPS, TACTICS), Justice (SSHRM, GEAL), and Anti-Corruption (ACTION)

Data party purpose:

- Engagement with donors and counterparts on usability of collected data
- Integration of findings into day to day operations
- Sharing findings and providing access to dashboards
- Design of new projects and activities based on the findings



Evidence-based programming

- Breeding and Training Facility for K9s
- Rehabilitation of Infrastructure for police stations and infrastructure profiles for police stations
- Community policing and addressing basic security needs (family disputes, pickpocketing, robbery, car stealing) and not only terrorism
- Police checkpoints, more patrols, and street lights





Example of most mentioned crimes by PD community, police officers and PD Commanders


Most mentioned crimes - Community/PD




Most mentioned crimes - Police/PD




Most Mentioned Crimes - Commander

- Includes incentive in the form of mobile payments for people answering most or fastest






Respondents per Province




Respondents per Gender



Gender by Province




Respondents per Ethnicity




Respondents per Employment status




Respondent employment status by Province




Community respondents employment status by PD










Total Number of Police Officers per PD



Build useful tools for your clients and counterparts. You're designing for the field, not for your donor's HQ.




Don't shy away from the difficult tasks like really understanding why people make the choices and act they way they do: today's tools allow you to do some incredible things with information sets we didn't even know really existed


Give information results immediately you have them. Don't be governed by the reporting cycle.


Who would you think of to contact as a first priority in order to seek for justice?
