# Monitoring and Performance Evaluation Guidelines



**Goal:** Provide a comprehensive and unified reference for state' employees to explain the concept of results-based management, its steps and tools, and how to implement it. This includes monitoring the implementation of their plans and programs, evaluating their results and impact, and providing reports consistently.






"**Decent Life** is the largest national initiative implemented by the Egyptian state to develop rural areas, aiming to improve the quality of life for **60%** of Egypt's population. By the end of 2025, the first phase, consisting of **23,000** projects with a cost exceeding **350** billion L.E, will be completed, benefiting **18** million citizens and improving their quality of life by approximately **65** percentage points in terms of basic needs availability and accessibility."



# Relying on Evidence-Based Policies to Identify Targeted Areas and Sectors




**“The Development Gap Index”**: measures the status of development in targeted villages before implementing development interventions, based on performance indicators available in key sectors






## Example: Percentage of improvement in certain Basic Services








